- **Online Classes:** Their online school, **A11yLearn Academy**, offers classes for human resources and other professionals. These courses teach them how to make sure their workplaces are accessible.
- **T-shirts and More:** Their **A11yShop** sells t-shirts and other items. A part of the money they make goes to groups that support people with disabilities.
