

Writing Captions, Transcripts, and Audio Descriptions Checklist

Create accurate text equivalents of spoken words and information (like sound effects)
Include nonverbal cues when appropriate, such as laughter, crying, etc.
Create concise, yet clear, audio descriptions that describe without being overly verbose
Ensure audio descriptions don't overlap any other important audio, like dialogue
Identify different speakers in captions and transcripts, if not immediately apparent
Include timestamps in transcripts for clearer identification and navigation
Synchronize captions and audio descriptions to appear at approximately the same time
as their corresponding audio
